# State of the Industry

- Illinois, Louisiana and New Jersey recently enacted new security-breach notification laws mandating actions companies are required take in the event of a breach (similar statutes exist in more than 20 other states)

- Two-thirds of financial services firms have a defined security program in place

- However, in recent years millions of consumers have had their information lost or stolen when organizations have neglected to properly protect personal information.
  - CardSystems Solutions Inc. experienced a security breach in early 2005 exposing data on potentially more than 40 million payment card accounts
  - UPS Inc. recently lost data containing the names of 3.9 million CitiGroup customers

  - Common Criteria is an internationally-recognized standard used by governments and other organizations to assess security and assurance of information technology products.
  - As a Common Criteria testing lab accredited under both the U.S. scheme (NIAP) and the German scheme (BSI), atsec offers Common Criteria consulting, readiness assessment, and evaluation services.
- **ISO/IEC 27001 Services**
  - ISO/IEC 27001 (formerly known as BS 7799-2) provides internationally-accepted standardized criteria to evaluate information security from a business processes point of view.
  - atsec offers readiness assessment and risk management consulting services for businesses seeking BS 7799 conformance certification.

- **FIPS 140-2 Services**
  - Federal Information Processing Standard (FIPS) 140-2, Security Requirements for Cryptographic Modules specifies requirements related to the secure design and implementation of cryptographic modules that protect sensitive or valuable data.
  - atsec offers FIPS 140-2 consulting and readiness assessment services.
- **Embedded Systems Consulting**
  - An embedded system is a special-purpose computer system that is completely encapsulated by the device it controls or monitors.


