What we need is a place where we can simply search or browse for what we want to watch, and easily link to that content without having to go to a bunch of different places."

webrTV hopes to be the answer to those issues. We are trying to become the one single place where people can turn-to to find out whatever they want to know about video via the internet. We have built a comprehensive guide which covers video providers, their shows, and the episodes in those shows. We include searchable categories and topics for those shows, and we have a built-in rating system which lets our users vote upon the providers, shows, and episodes so that people can find the popular content easily. This guide is unique because unlike other video guides, we allow and encourage our users to submit content to the directory. This helps keep the content in the guide fresh, interesting, and relevant.

To further enhance the experience, webrTV has built a rich community around the content in the guide. Our users can save listings in the guide to their profiles for easy one-click future access. Users can also create lists of buddies on webrTV and track what they are bookmarking and voting upon. All of webrTV's users get a personal blog, where they can keep a journal of their own experiences related to online video and IPTV.
