When to contact a lawyer?

- Statute of limitations vary from state to state, and at most you have 3 years from the date of the incident to bring a wrongful death or survival action.



How much will it cost

- There are a lot of different types of retainer agreements. In wrongful death cases and personal injury cases our firm, like many others, have what are called contingency fee agreements.
- A contingency fee agreement means that you pay the firm if you recover any fees for your claims.





Who pays for the costs

- You should understand what costs are, and to what extent you are responsible, before you sign a retainer agreement with any firm.
