## Know Your Rights

- If you have a strong family history of breast cancer, insurance companies may provide access to early screening with mammograms.
- Women have access to reconstruction following a lumpectomy or mastectomy for treatment of breast cancer or if they are at high risk (such as BRCA positive or have a very strong family history of breast cancer).
- Women are encouraged to get advice prior to any surgical procedure and to contact a trusted health care professional for further information.
- State and Federal Laws mandate that insurance carriers cover the cost of reconstructive procedures following a mastectomy, as well as symmetry procedures for the other breast (Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998). Sometimes reconstructive procedures following lumpectomy may also be covered.
- Women deserve the right to hope, healing and to happiness during their breast cancer journey. Survivors can be Thrivers!
