

Ethiopian Airlines Launches First-Ever Nonstop Service from Chicago to Africa

CHICAGO, June 11, 2018

Ethiopian Airlines Group, the largest Aviation Holding Company in Africa, is pleased to announce it will link Chicago and Africa for the first time today with its inaugural flight from O'Hare International Airport to Addis Ababa, Ethiopia's capital.

The flight will be operated together with Star Alliance partner United Airlines and is scheduled to expediently connect flyers from Chicago and the Midwest to more than 55 destinations in Africa.

Ethiopian, a SKYTRAX certified Four Star Global airline, will fly the Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner on the route, providing guests an exceptional flight experience with bigger windows, enhanced cabin lighting and more overall comfort for the approximately 14 hour journey.
